**WITH A BACHELORS DEGREE:** 4,000 total Internship hours or If you complete 18 semester units in addictions you will reduce the number of required hours of employment experience to 1,500 hrs.

1,500 hours of supervised internship along with the completion of 12 college credits in the field of substance use disorders

If applying from out of Nevada, please provide verification of employment in the field.
