Primary Counselor – Mental Health Focus

Reports to Clinical Director. Mental Health/Substance Abuse Counselor shall work 40 hours per week; 20 clinical hours. Primary work location shall be at the administrative or outpatient offices. Additionally, counselor shall have access to all equipment available at The Ridge House, Inc. administrative offices.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must have minimum of Master's Degree in Counseling and be Licensed as a Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT) or a Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) in Nevada, or a registered and properly supervised intern in one of these three areas.
- 2. Licensed as a Substance Abuse Counselor preferred.
- 3. Must have two years experience, or education equivalent, in substance abuse treatment field
- 4. Must be experienced in both individual and group counseling
- 5. Must have working knowledge of community support groups such as AA/NA
- 6. Knowledge of criminal justice system as it applies to clients on parole/probation preferred
- 7. Possess efficient communication skills and the ability to work as a team member
- 8. Must be self motivated and able to set professional goals for him/herself and the program
- 9. Possess maturity of judgment and ability to apply common sense to difficult situations
- 10. Possess appropriate assertiveness skills through confronting negative attitudes and behaviors of clients

Responsibilities:

- 1. Interview clients and assess their treatment needs
- 2. Perform intake process in accordance to policies and procedures
- 3. Develop and implement, with client, an individualized treatment plan, reviewing and updating as appropriate
- 4. Meet monthly with each client on caseload for individual counseling sessions as appropriate
- 5. Facilitate group counseling sessions
- 6. Provide client documentation in electronic treatment file within 3 working days of contact.
- 7. Maintain communication with Department of Parole and Probation, judges and all other stakeholders as necessary
- 8. Completion of all month-end progress reports by 5th day of following month
- 9. Work within the scope of license making appropriate referrals when necessary
- 10. Attend staff meeting and client staffing weekly
- 11. Develop and implement, with client, an appropriate aftercare plan prior to discharge
- 12. Notify Clinical Director of problems and appropriate plan of action to be taken or request guidance to resolve any issues
- 13. Maintain frequent communication with Clinical Director ensuring a united approach to treatment
- 14. Attend necessary classes keeping abreast of treatment techniques and maintaining certification requirements
- 15. Other duties as assigned
