

Clinical Supervision Refresher SELF-PACED ONLINE COURSE

This 6-hour Clinical Supervision Refresher self-paced online course is intended for existing Clinical Supervisors in Nevada seeking to renew their license.

The course focuses on the concepts taught and standards discussed in the initial Clinical Supervision 12-hour training. Supervisors will practice skills to help shape the delivery of high quality, effective clinical services to those seeking assistance for substance use disorders. This training is aimed at preparing clinical supervisors to observe job performance, provide feedback and coaching, prioritize learning needs, develop achievable learning objectives, and continue monitoring performance to assess effectiveness. The course is heavy on case scenarios and ethics. This course requires the completion of a workbook which you will receive once you are enrolled.
